**EASEMENT FOR COUNTY HIGHWAY  
ROAD SURVEY 973**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, A.A. BURNAND, JR. and CLARA A. BURNAND, (also known as Clara K. Burnand), husband and wife, Grantors, of ---, County of San Diego, State of California, owners of the hereinafter described lands, for and in consideration of ONE AND NO/100 Dollars (\$1.00), to them in hand paid by the County of San Diego, State of California, or on its behalf, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the benefits to accrue to them by reason of the location and establishment by the County of San Diego, State of California of a public highway upon, over and across said lands, do hereby signify their approval of and consent to the location, establishment and construction of such highway thereon and --- do, by these presents hereby grant, convey and dedicate to the County of San Diego, State of California, grantees, the right of way and incidents thereto for such public highway upon, over and across the said lands, hereinafter described, lying and being in the County of San Diego, State of California, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Section 7, T. 10 S., R. 6 E., S. B. B. & M.

Said highway right of way hereby granted, conveyed and dedicated is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

PARCEL NO. 1:- A strip of land 60 feet wide, 30 feet on each side of the following described center line: Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section 7, as shown on Record of Survey Map No. 1114 on file in the office of the Recorder of said San Diego County, from which the northwest corner of said section bears N. 89° 29' 10" W. 1330.85 feet; thence S. 0° 27' 15" E. 5066.69 feet to a point on the south line of said Section 7 from which the southwest corner of said section bears N. 89° 34' 58" W. 1329.78 feet.

PARCEL NO. 2:- A strip of land 200 feet wide, 100 feet on each side of the following described center line: Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section 7, as shown on said Record of Survey Map No. 1114, from which the northwest corner of said section bears N. 89° 29' 10" W. 2761.70 feet; thence S. 0° 26' 33" E. 5064.25 feet to a point on the south line of said Section 7 from which the southwest corner of said section bears N. 89° 34' 58" W. 2759.55 feet.

PARCEL NO. 4:- A strip of land 60 feet wide lying west of and contiguous to the East line of said Section 7, as shown on said Record of Survey Map 1114.

PARCEL NO. 5:- The North 30 feet of said Section 7, as shown on said Record of Survey Map 1114, EXCEPTING therefrom those portions thereof lying within Parcels 1, 2, 3 and 4 above described.

PARCEL NO. 6:- That portion of the South 30 feet of said Section 7, as shown on said Record of Survey Map No. 1114, lying east of the east line of Parcel No. 1 above described, EXCEPTING therefrom those portions thereof lying within Parcels 2, 3 and 4 above described.

Said right of way above described consists of --- acre, more or less.

For the consideration named above we hereby grant to the County of San Diego the privilege and right to extend drainage structures and excavation and embankment slopes beyond the limits of the above described right of way where required for the construction and maintenance of said County Highway.

And the undersigned, the said grantors, do hereby waive all claim for compensation for any and all damages on account of the location, establishment and construction of said highway; and do hereby grant to the County of San Diego, State of California, all trees, growths (growing or that may hereafter grow) and roadbuilding materials within said right of way, together with the right to use the same in such manner and at such locations as said grantee may deem proper, needful or necessary in the construction, reconstruction and maintenance of said highway.

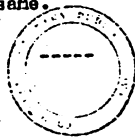

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EASEMENT FOR COUNTY HIGHWAY ROAD SURVEY 972

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, NOEL CRICKMER AND RUTH B. CRICKMER, husband and wife; A. A. BURNAND, JR. AND CLARA A. BURNAND, husband and wife, and HAL G. HOTCHKISS, Grantors, of ---, County of San Diego State of California, owners of the hereinafter described lands, for and in consideration of ONE AND NO/100 dollars (\$1.00), to them in hand paid by the County of San Diego, State of California, or on its behalf, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the benefits to accrue to them by reason of the location and establishment by the County of San Diego, State of California of a public highway upon, over and across said lands, do hereby signify their approval of and consent to the location, establishment and construction of such highway thereon and --- do, by these presents hereby grant, convey and dedicate to the County of San Diego, State of California, grantee, the right of way and incidents thereto for such public highway upon, over and across the said lands, hereinafter described, lying and being in the County of San Diego, State of California, and particularly described as follows to-wit:

The North 1/2 of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 22, and the West 1/2 of NW 1/4 and North 1/2 of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 23, in T. 11 S., R. 6 E., S.B.B. & M.

Said highway right of way hereby granted, conveyed and dedicated is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

PARCEL NO. 1:- A strip of land 60 feet wide across said West 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 23, lying 30 feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at a point on the west line of said Section 23 from which the northwest corner of said section bears N. 0° 36' 45" W. 700.05 feet; thence S. 59° 37' 40" E. 782.25 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve to the right having a radius of 977.63 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of 14° 34' 15" a distance of 248.62 feet; thence tangent to said curve S. 45° 03' 25" E. 354.30 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve to the right having a radius of 1695.77 feet; thence along said curve through a central angle of 6° 45' a distance of 199.78 feet; thence tangent to said curve S. 38° 18' 25" E. 127.39 feet to a point on the East line of said W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Section 23 from which the southeast corner of said portion of said Section bears S. 0° 32' 07" E. 898.75 feet.

The side lines of said strip shall be prolonged or shortened so as to terminate in the east and west lines of said W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Section 23.
